I have understood from [REDACTED] that he has already "warned" you about what is our planning for RAC 39 B regarding glyphosate and what we would need for that.

The Glyphosate Task Force plays a role in the glyphosate case. We would therefore like to invite an expert from the Task Force, as an expert accompanying the ECPA stakeholder observer, to **contribute to the key issues discussion of ECHA's Committee for Risk Assessment (RAC) on the CLH dossier of Glyphosate (ISO)**, which will take place at the 39th Meeting of the Committee for Risk Assessment (RAC-39B) on

7 December 2016, 2.00-6.30pm Helsinki EET

In order for the expert to contribute to the discussions, he or she is asked to prepare a presentation (power point format) which should focus on the hazard profile of Glyphosate (ISO). In particular, it should

- Provide a **hazard assessment** of Glyphosate (ISO) in accordance with the criteria of Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 (**CLP Regulation**) and pertinent ECHA Guidance;
- Focus primarily on the **carcinogenicity** and **reproductive toxicity** hazards;
- Clarify on what information the hazard assessment is based;
- Abstain from presenting mixture issues and issues of biodiversity;
- Abstain from presenting risk and socio-economic considerations;
- Abstain from presenting regulatory or economic downstream consequences of classification;
- Be strictly science-orientated and abstain from conveying political claims.

The time allocated for the presentation of the slides is 20 minutes, followed by 10 minutes of questions and answers from the plenary members.

The presentation should be delivered to the RAC SECR by Friday, 5th November 2016, end of business. The Secretariat will make the presentation available to RAC members and the RAC stakeholder observers.

You will receive the invitation to the RAC-39B meeting as usual. Nevertheless, it would be fruitful if you could already now identify a suitable expert to contribute as outlined above. And possibly identify those who would have to agree within ECPA or the Task Force to any slides to be presented at RAC, which I can imagine will take some coordination time and effort.
