Subject: Your requests on access to standardisation inspection reports regarding Germany

Dear Mr Fischer,

Thank you for your e-mail of 16 May 2017, in which you apply for access to all standardisation visit reports regarding Germany from July 2014 and 2013, in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents (OJ L 145 of 31 May 2001, p. 43).

The scope of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 was extended to documents held by the European Aviation Safety Agency by Art. 58 para. 1 of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008¹.

As you may know the Agency conducts standardisation inspections in many different domains that are defined in Art. 9 (1) of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 628/2013². To be able to process your application properly, I invite you to clarify your request and indicate, whether you are specifically interested in receiving documents concerning one or more of the following domains: airworthiness, air crew (which includes licensing, medical and simulators), air operations, ramp inspections or ATM/ANS. Please note that the Agency has not yet commenced the standardisation exercise in the field of aerodromes yet.

You also indicate that you would like to receive the standardisation visit reports regarding Germany "from July 2014 and 2013". In relation to this I would ask you if you could better clarify the timeframe in which you are interested.
