Following yesterday's tour de table, today (1) MS expressed their final intentions of vote in Standing Committee on the renewal of the approval of Glyphosate and (2) COM explained the follow-up.

Final intention of vote

This means that the formal vote would be a "no opinion" (i.e. the "GMO situation"), unless a big MS changes its view and supports the draft renewal of approval.

Following this intention of vote, COM announced that, without a "clear qualified majority" by MS, this draft measure "will not be voted". COM wanted "a clear political support" for this measure to be voted. COM invited MS to indicate any change of position by 18 March.
