**Subject: Application for access to documents under Regulation 1049/2001 - GestDem 2013/1654**

Dear Ms Trentea,

I refer to your email of 25 March 2013, registered on 26 March 2013, in which you require, pursuant to Regulation No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents<sup>1</sup>, *documents which contain the following information:*

- 1. List of procurement contracts and List of grants awarded by European Commission's directorates in 2012 to Danish Institute for Human Rights (DIHR). The list should contain amounts, expense type, action type, responsible department.*
- 2. List of procurement contracts and List of grants on-going in 2013, in case of framework contracts and/or grants concluded on multi annual basis (with same details as above).*

Figures for the years 2012 and 2013 are not yet available at central level and relevant information has to be searched in each individual Directorate-General. You will shortly receive a reply from the Directorate-General for Justice. We are currently checking whether any other Directorate-General awarded contracts or grants to this Institute in 2012 or 2013. Therefore, we are not in a position to reply to your request within the prescribed time limit expiring on 19 April 2013. In accordance with Article 7(3) of Regulation 1049/2001, we have to extend this period by 15 working days until 15 May 2013.
