Request for access to Frontex documents

This letter is to respond to your application received on 28 July 2017, requesting all documents that fall under and/or pertain to "Italy's proposals regarding Joint Operation Triton" submitted to the European Border and Coast Guard Agency as indicated in point 1, bullet 1, sub-bullet 3 of the European Commission's 'Action plan on measures to support Italy, reduce pressure along the Central Mediterranean route and increase solidarity'.

Firstly, I would like to inform you that Frontex does not hold Italy's proposals regarding Joint Operation Triton. Frontex agrees nevertheless to provide you with the minutes and agenda of the meeting held in Frontex HQ on 11 July 2017 and relevant Working Group meeting held in Frontex HQ on 24 July 2017 and the respective press releases.
