I refer to your e-mails dated 14 and 18 September 2017 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 19 September 2017 under the above-mentioned reference number.

You have made the same request to a number of other Directorates General who will respond in due course. This reply relates only to the documents of Directorate General for Climate Action.

I regret to inform you that the Directorate General for Climate Action does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application.

Indeed, as specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Given that the Directorate General for Climate Action does not hold any such documents corresponding to the description given in your application, it is not in a position to handle your request.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
