I refer to your email dated 2 January 2018, in which you make a request for:

"All text messages (i.e., SMS messages) and other mobile-phone-based text communications (e.g., WhatsApp, Telegram, iMessage, Facebook Chat, SnapChat, Slack, Facebook and Twitter "direct messages," Signal Messenger, Wire, etc.) sent by – or on behalf of – EU Commissioner Johannes Hahn addressed or "CC'd" to his Head of Cabinet Michael Karnitschnig, from 1 September 2017 to 31 October 2017 inclusive, on work-specific devices operated by or otherwise under the control of Commissioner Hahn."

Please note that SMS messages and other mobile-phone-based text communications sent out or received in the professional context which are short-lived communications cannot be considered as documents drawn up or received by the institution and in its possession, in the meaning of Article 3(a) of Regulation (EC) 1049/2001. Therefore, your application for access to documents does not fall under the scope of Regulation (EC) 1049/2001.

For reasons of good order, I am informing you of the legal remedies available, in line with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001. You are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position. Such a
