General impression: PE is working very seriously at the voluntary commitment. However we are waiting for a more concrete proposal, which we would receive on 5 Sept.

PE explained:

C-- biosts

- willingness to work on a voluntary commitment
- to be structured like the voluntary commitment of the PVC industry, Vinyl+ (see: http://www.vinylplus.eu/)
 - o Board,
 - o Potential commitments around 4 objectives
 - Increasing recycling
 - Reducing negative externalities
 - Better resource consumption
 - Facilitating the future (e.g. design)

Under each of these objectives there would be specific measures

- o Monitoring: incl. benchmarks, auditing and reporting
- Process
 - o Several meetings already held by PE's core team, which includes a couple of firms and PE
 - o By 5/9, PE will make a more concrete proposal meeting @ DG ENV, Grow invited.
 - o On 6-7/9, a coordination meeting of the core team, also to discuss ENV & GROW suggestions o On 25/9 PE board meeting
 - o In Nov., next PE board meeting, with possibly the adoption of the voluntary commitment
- This voluntary commitment would be the umbrella agreement for other commitments, such as Vinyl+, and embrace all plastic types
- Broadening the partners is needed:

o For the moment, only discussion within the plastics producers industry and informal contacts with the plastics converters (EUPC) and recyclers (PRE) o Need to link to the national level, with many different circumstances. o No contacts yet with part of industry that uses plastics o Possible links are: Europen (packaging), Food & Drink Europe (food packaging), Business Europe, Ellen MacArthur Foundation (EMF), o Possibly first

To do:

- look at how Vinyl+ or other voluntary agreements are set up within the EC procedures (official recognition? COM participation as observer / monitoring committee member?)
- check market coverage of such a commitment (i.e. what is the representativeness of PE on the EU plastics market)

At the Plastics conference, and the preceding CEO breakfast, FVP might state:

Acknowledgement of good work

focus on packaging

- EC interested if it delivers
- Call to make real progress and invite industry across the value chain to join in => It would also be a possibility to put these elements in a press statement, together with other elements linked to the conference
