I confirm that [REDACTED] will participate in the JMC in Ottawa. He is well aware of our needs regarding the missing certificates (meat based products without 30 days and Bresola with EU beef)

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are also part of the "Canada sub-group" within Potsdam and are "candidates" to elaborate the proposal to be submitted to the Canadians for the Listeria sampling. They are still in a phase of reasoning and they still have to study the requirements of the Canadian legislation but, as I understand it, their idea would be to adopt the US sampling for Canada. This is to simplify the management by the veterinary services. At the JMC they would like to present a comparison table between the provisions of the EU / Canada rules but not yet the proposal for the new sampling plan.
