Travel

Information how to reach [REDACTED] is given on:

At the train station you can purchase a ticket to Ede-Wageningen from one of the yellow vending machines or at the NS Service Desk.

Trains depart from Schiphol Airport to Ede-Wageningen via Utrecht almost every 15 minutes. Take a direct train to Ede-Wageningen or take an intercity train from Schiphol to Utrecht. Once in Utrecht, switch to a train in the direction of Arnhem or Nijmegen. Your final stop is Ede-Wageningen. Travel time from Schiphol to Ede-Wageningen is approximately 60 to 75 minutes.

The Valleilijn bus (line 84 and 88) runs between Ede-Wageningen station and bus station in Wageningen and passes Wageningen Campus

When you stop at Wageningen Campus, you have to go to the Lumen Building, which it is the first building on your right hand side

NB: if you travel first to Hotel De Wageningsche Berg, take either bus lines: 52 and 88 to Wageningen, and or Arnhem. When you take line 88, you will need to change to line 51 at Wageningen bus station heading towards Arnhem. At the third stop, "Wageningen berg", leave the bus.
