I refer to your e-mail of 6 August 2018, registered on 21 August 2018, in which you submit a confirmatory application in accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents¹ (hereafter 'Regulation 1049/2001').

In your confirmatory application, you ask the European Commission 'to reply precisely' to the three following questions which had already been raised in your initial request dealt with by the Directorate-General for Employment, Social Affairs and Inclusion:

- '1) Quelles sont les suites données par la Belgique à cet arrêt CJUE C-317/14?
- 2) Où en est le suivi par la Commission européenne de cet arrêt CJUE C-317/14?
