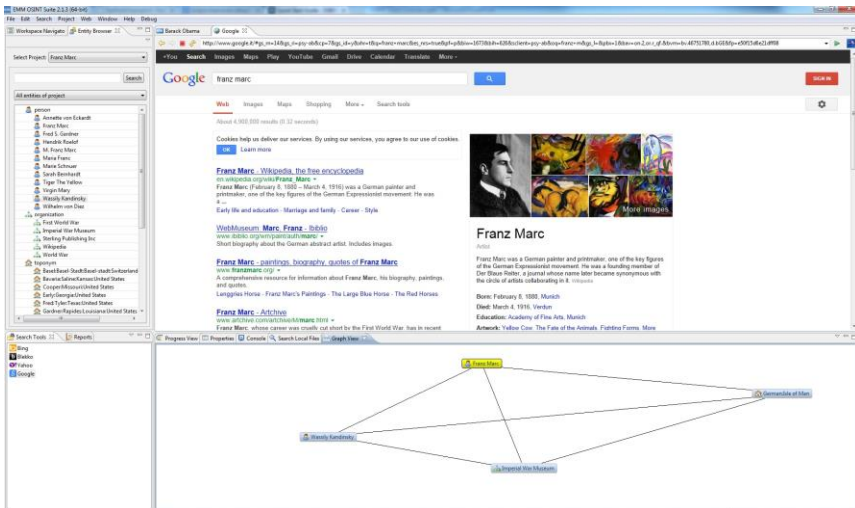

What it is in a Nutshell

The EMM OSINT Suite is a **desktop software application** which helps to **find, acquire and analyse** data from the Internet and local sources



Acquire Documents

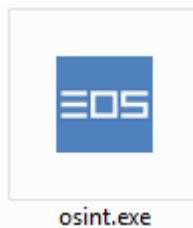
- Internet

 - Acquire documents
 - Extract information
 - Analyse

Features in a Nutshell

The software contains a collection of tools for core OSINT processes

- **Acquisition**
 - Internet Search
 - Crawling of targeted sites
 - File Import
- **Processing**
 - Text Extraction (HTML, PDF, MS Office 97 & 2007, etc.)
 - Entity Extraction with built-in types (names, places, email, URL, VAT, etc.)
 - User defined custom types
 - Categorisation of Documents (Category Matching)
- **Analysis**
 - Entity Browser
 - Basic Graph View
 - Custom Reports & Export

Runs on typical desktop PCs (easy install, easy upgrade)

Community Support

Supporting EU policies to improve use of OSINT tools and techniques

- **EMM OSINT Suite Tool**
 - **Base line tool for LE authorities to „get started“**
 - **Community providing input, for example which entity types are needed**
 - **Community Web Site**
 - **Continuous development and keeping it operational**

 - **Started 5 years ago**
 - **Initially based around presentations from practitioners in the EU Member states**
