<b>Title</b>	Acronym recognition and resolution in OSINT Suite
<b>Description</b>	An acronym is a shortened form inferred from the original name (long form) of an entity. It is usually generated by taking into account the initial letters of each word that compose the long form. The aim of this deliverable is to develop and implement the recognition and resolution of acronyms in the OSINT suite. The recognition of acronyms implies to detect tokens in the documents which are composed of uppercase letters exclusively, whereas the resolution deals with the identification of the entity or entities (long forms) related to the acronym.
<b>Concepts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Short Form (SF): is the abbreviation of the entity (acronym)</li><li>• Long Form (LF): is the original name of the entity</li><li>• Type: is the type of the entity represented by the acronym. Three main types of entities are recognized in OSINT:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ organization (o)</li><li>○ toponym or location (t)</li><li>○ person (p)</li></ul></li><li>• Token: a word in the document</li></ul>
