Dear Sir,

We refer to your e-mail dated 29/08/2018 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 29/08/2018 under the above-mentioned reference number. We also refer to our letter dated 18/09/2018 in which we have informed you about an extension of time limit to 10 October 2018.

The handling of your request involves the assessment of documents originating from third parties. The need to consult the third parties concerned in accordance with Article 4(4) of Regulation 1049/2001, cannot be expected to be completed within the normal time limits set out in Article 7 of Regulation 1049/2001.

Based on the above-mentioned provision and contrary to our decision we have to propose a new extension of time limit with additional 10 working days, as set out in Article 6.3 of Regulation 1049/2001.
