Dear Mr Brunning,

We refer to your e-mail dated 01/10/2018, registered on the same day under the above-mentioned reference number, by which you made a request pursuant to Regulation 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents<sup>1</sup>.

You asked: *"I am requesting all documents that you have created or received regarding the UK's departure from the EU. If this is not possible, I'd like all the presentations you've created."*

Since the beginning of the negotiations on the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union in accordance with Article 50 of the Treaty on European Union, the European Commission has proactively published EU position papers, the draft Withdrawal Agreement and draft papers related to the areas of the future EU-UK relationship, which can be found on a dedicated website:


