The European Climate Foundation has recently launched a major report called *"Net Zero By 2050: From Whether To How"* (summary available [here](#)) assessing the feasibility and implications of reaching net zero emissions in the EU by mid-century. This was closely followed by a related report *"Funding Innovation to Deliver EU Competitive Climate Leadership"* (summary available [here](#)).

Both of these reports are the outcome of significant engagement with expert stakeholders and we believe the insights they bring are very relevant to the forthcoming publication of the EU's draft Long Term Strategy for decarbonisation, and also the discussions on the design of funding instruments relating to research and innovation, and those involved in structuring Horizon Europe and other related innovation funding instruments.
