They lagged that due to the new 75% regional content requirement in the USMCA, many EU firms upplying the US market would now find themselves unable to take advantage of the EU's rade agreements with Mexico and Canada. AmCham EU inquired about the possibility that the US would seek to introduce a non-market economy clause in the agreement with the EU — similarly to what they have pushed in the USMCA. Art.4.1(a)
