





Main Products Traded

INA Export to EU

Coal, palm oil, copper ores, natural rubber, coal, footwear, furniture, coconuts, video recording or reproduction, printing machinery, industrial monocarboxylic, transmission app for radio telephony, coffee, electrical transformers

INA Import from EU

Electrical apparatus for line telephony, other aircraft, motor vehicle for transportation of goods, recovered (waste and scrap) paper & paper board, electronic IC & micro-assemblies, machinery for grinding & sorting

Simple Average Applied Tariffs:	INA	EU
All Goods	6.8%	5.1%
Agriculture	8.4%	12.8%
Non-Agriculture	6.6%	4.0%
Non-Ad valorem Tariffs (% total tariff lines)	0.2%	4.7%

NTMs in the EU

- Renewable Energy Directive RED (emission of palm oil biodiesel 36%)
- Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals REACH (registration of producers & importers who produce or import > 1 ton of chemicals/year)
- Illegal, Unreported, Unregulated Fishing IUUF (keeping illegally caught fish off the EU market)
- Forest Law Enforcement, Governance & Trade Voluntary Partnership Agreement
 FLEGT—VAP
- Other issues such as palm oil...
