**Subject:** Request for access to documents

Ref.: Your request of 27 February 2019 registered under reference GestDem 2019/1146

Dear Ms Martí,

I refer to your application mentioned above, addressed to the Secretariat General of the European Commission, by which you request access to documents under Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents<sup>1</sup>. Your request concerns "[...] any document or information related to the preparation of the Commission Decision of 25 November 2014 on the publication of information on meetings held between Members of the commission and organizations or self-employed individuals".<sup>2</sup>

As you were informed, your request has been split into two separated parts: the part to be dealt with by the Secretariat General (request reference GestDem 2019/1174) and the part to be dealt with by the Legal Service (request reference GestDem 2019/1146). The present reply concerns the part under the responsibility of the Legal Service. I understand that the Secretariat General has already sent you the documents in its possession.

In response to your request, I would like to inform you that the Legal Service has not identified any document originating from it matching the terms of your request.

Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 states that "[t]his Regulation shall apply to all documents held by an institution, that is to say, documents drawn up or received by it and in its possession, in all areas of activity of the European Union". Since the Legal Service does not hold any document corresponding to the description given in your application, it is not in a position to fulfil your request.
