We refer to your applications dated 1 July 2019 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 10 July 2019 under the reference number 2019/3961. Please find below the replies to your query:

1. The number of landfill sites in each Member State can be consulted in the last implementation report for Directive 1999/31/EC on the landfill of waste, published by the Commission on 16 April 2018. Link: http://ec.europa.eu/environment/archives/waste/reporting/pdf/Final_Implementati_on_Report_2013_2015_Landfill_Directive.pdf. The Commission does not hold landfill site-specific information related to the size of the landfill site, the amount of waste landfilled in each site up until now, and the amount of waste accepted on a daily basis. This information should be available at the level of the competent authorities in each Member State.
2. Please find attached to this letter, a list of bad application cases on the Landfill Directive (1999/31/EC) registered with the Commission.
3. The Commission does not hold specific information related to the economic profit generated by the landfill sites in the EU.
