Subject: Case 2019-23 - Your application for access to documents

Dear Mr. Hai,

We refer to your e-mail dated 08/07/2019 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 11/07/2019 under reference number 2019/23.

You requested access to documents containing the following information:

"There has been some talk in the UK that the GDPR funds collected by the ICO are shared between the UK government and the EU for data protection management.

Can you tell me how much money has the ICO given to the EU from fines"

We regret to inform you that the EDPB does not hold any documents that contain information on how the UK SA deals with the money collected through fines.

Please note that in accordance with Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, the right of access under this regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the EDPB. Therefore, the EDPB is not in a position to fulfil your request.
