Dear Mr. [REDACTED],
This is [REDACTED] from Korea Cosmetic Association.
We are using the CosIng as a great reference and it help us a lot for understanding the EU regulation about cosmetic ingredients.
Recently, while I classify the prohibited ingredients, there is some ingredient that is not clear for me.

My Question is...

In the AnnexII, the substance, 'Narcotics, natural and synthetic: All substances listed in Tables I and II of the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs signed in New York on 30 March 1961' is on the list and there are 146 Identified ingredients or substances e.g. under this substance ^ㄱ

Among these, 'Cannabidiol' is also listed. So I think 'Cannbidiol' is banned ingredient.

However, when I search 'Cannabidiol' in another site, there is allowed in cosmetic when CBD obtained from cannabis, cannabis resin, cannabis extracts and cannabis tinctures originating from the seeds and leaves that are not accompanied with the fruiting tops of the cannabis plant.

What is EU position on cannabis and cannabis-derived ingredients in cosmetics?

Is allowed in cosmetic when CBD obtained from cannabis, cannabis resin, cannabis extracts and cannabis tinctures originating from the seeds and leaves that are not accompanied with the fruiting tops of the cannabis plant?

Please note that national legislations on controlled substances may also apply.

Also, '[CANNABIS SATIVA CALLUS EXTRACT](#)' is not regulated in Annex II.

Is Cannabis sativa callus related ingredient allowed in cosmetic?
