Status on Safety Reporting and CT2 Extension



KEY HIGHLIGHTS - Reporting period: 10/06/2019 - 21/06/2019

Safety Reporting

- All deliverables have been submitted to EMA. The 2nd review cycle is on-going.
- The acceptance period finishes on 02/07.

CT1 Extension (fixing 52 pre-UAT bugs)

- 49 items have been shown to the POs and all of them were closed.
- One bug was reopened by EMA, but fixed already. It has been deployed within the first development version of Release 1 Sprint 7. Planned to be validated with EMA in IT4U environments in Release 1 Sprint 7.
- Two are pending to be shown due to liferay issues, the technical analysis is on-going to reach the solution.

Regression Testing 2

- Regression testing 2 completed by IT4U.
 - out of test cases are blocked by an issue
- Approximately items identified between regression testing 1 and 2. Out of them, items were unknown from regression testing 1 (categorization are under review).
- IT4U and EMA working together to validate (and improve if applicable) testing coverage

Progress Status Update – Reporting Period

Release Management (planning, development and testing) activities

- Release 1 Sprint 7 implementation started on 11/06, it is going as planned.
- Release 1 Sprint 8 scope has been approved by Product Owners, EMA and IT4U. Focus on application creation
 and evaluation, and RMS selection. The proposal includes 4 technical issues and 27 functional issues.

Backlog management activities

- 463 items (from Member States POs) and 455 items (from Sponsors POs) have been received and are "open*". Currently, 90% of the total functional historical backlog (1022 items*) have been reviewed. From those items reviewed, 97% of them have business value and of which, at least, 444 items have business value 3**.
- Currently, the IT4U team is starting the consolidation of these items (i.e. reviewing items that have different business value from MS and Sponsors POs) and updating JIRA.
- The assignment of the Technical Value to technical debt items is on-going by Technical Team

Analysis and Design activities

- A&D 3: the activities are completed as planned (35 items fully analysed and designed)
- A&D 4: analysis of the items is on-going (expecting 38 items to be analysed and designed)

^{*}Only considering the items that are open in JIRA. Up to now, POs have reviewed a total of 1134 items, from those 1022 are open in JIRA.

Release Management (planning, development and testing) activities

- Release 1 Sprint 7 will be completed, including FATA, SAT and business validation (09/07)
- Release 1 Sprint 8 the development will be completed (16/07) and the SAT will be starting
- Release 1 Sprint 9 scope to be agreed with Product Owners, EMA and IT4U (08-10/07).
- Release 2 meeting to take place with Expert Group (05/07) and the Release Plan 2 to be endorsed.

Backlog management activities

- · A consolidate view of the functional historical backlog to be shared with EMA and POs
- New and re-open backlog items will be analysed in 3 grooming sessions foreseen
- 30 items more will have Technical Value (assuming 10 per week)
- A projection on when the audit could take place will be presented.

Analysis and Design activities


- A&D 4 will be finished
