We refer to your email dated 19/11/2019 in which you make a revised request for access to documents, registered on 21/11/2019 under the above mentioned reference number.

We thank you for having narrowed down the scope of your request to: “...all communication from the European Commission to the Netherlands about nitrogen emissions in relation to Natura 2000 sites between 2014 and 2019...”
