Dear Ms Omidiran,

We refer to your e-mail dated 18/03/2020 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered under the above-mentioned reference number.

You request access to:

*All documentation, including but not limited to attendance lists, agendas, background papers, minutes/notes and email correspondence about or summarising, the following meeting:*

- *Meeting between Ditte Juul Jorgensen and European Chemical Industry Council (Cefic) regarding The role of the Energy Intensive Industries on 31/01/2020.*

Your application concerns the documents: Ares(2019)7869649, Ares(2019)7430335 and Ares(2020)2999658 .

Having examined the documents and the attachment requested under the provisions of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to documents, I have come to the conclusion that they can be disclosed. Complete disclosure of these documents is prevented by the exception concerning the protection of privacy and the integrity of the individual outlined in Article 4(1)(b) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, because it contains the following personal data:

- the name of Commission staff members not pertaining to the senior management;
- the names of other natural persons;
- handwritten signatures/abbreviated signatures of natural persons;
- other information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person [email address].

Article 9(1)(b) of the Data Protection Regulation does not allow the transmission of these personal data, except if you prove that it is necessary to have the data transmitted to you for a specific purpose in the public interest and where there is no reason to assume that the legitimate interests of the data subject might be prejudiced. In your request, you do not express any particular interest to have access to these personal data nor do you put forward any arguments to establish the necessity to have the data transmitted for a specific purpose in the public interest.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
