## Main issues:

- Chemical **pesticides reduction target** in the forthcoming Farm to Fork Strategy:
  - ECPA reminded that it takes time to put a new plant protection product on the market to replace dangerous products (11 years on average).
  - It advocated the possibility of using new breeding techniques to move towards sustainability
  - o It argued for the need to better take into account the risks linked to the use of pesticides, in particular through the prism of risk management.
- Impact of counterfeit and illegal pesticides:
  - Counterfeit and illegal pesticides represent 14% of the EU pesticides market.
  - Lack of harmonisation between EU countries concerning the placing of plant protection products on the national market.
