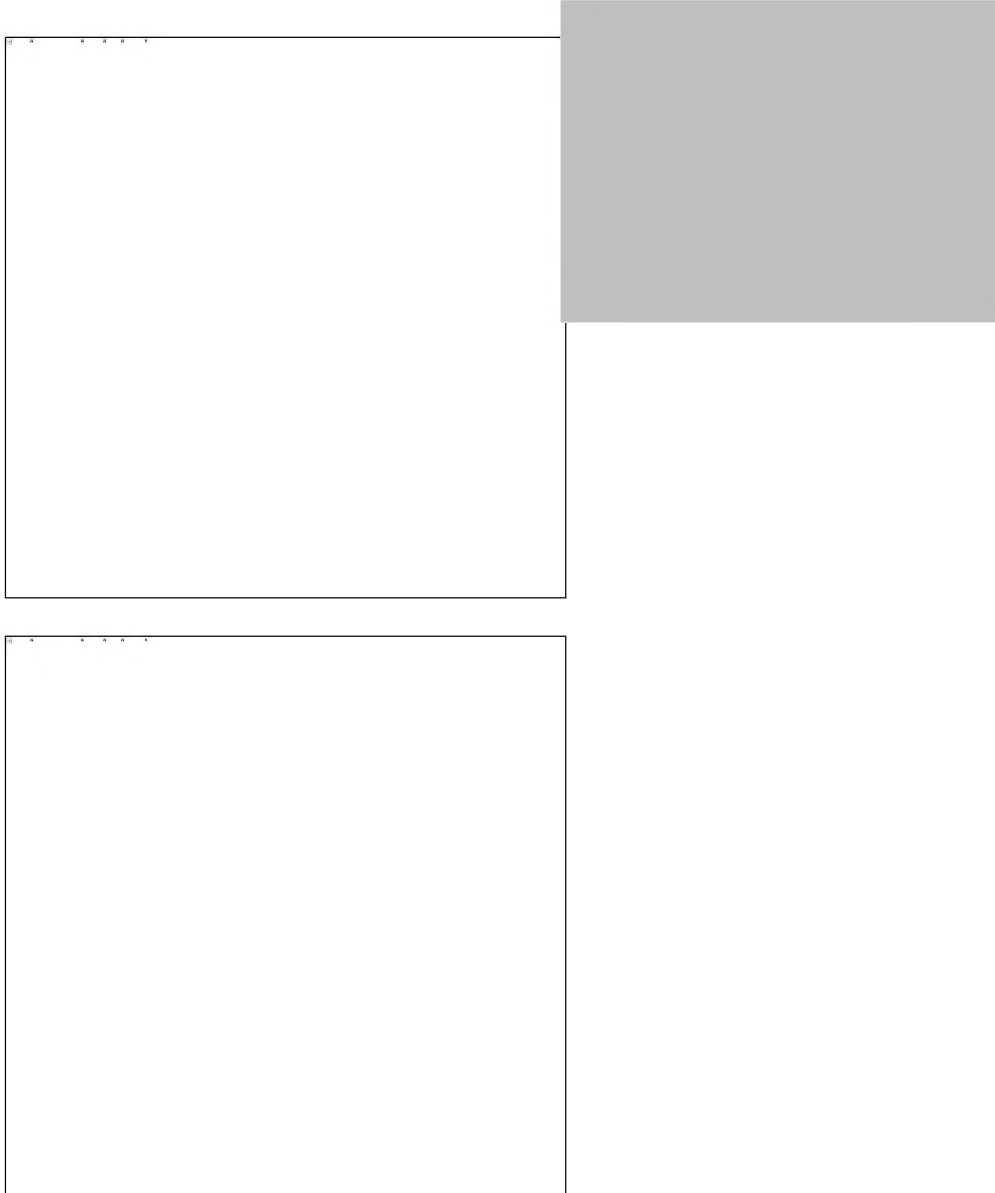

We plan to publish the report in 3-4 weeks' time. We want it to support the case for the higher EU 2030 climate target.

We plan to launch the report with a one-hour online event. We would be delighted if the Commissioner could speak at it. We haven't fixed a date yet.
