<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Protection of the public interest as regards: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – public security – defence and military matters – international relations – the financial, monetary or economic policy of the EU or a Member State • Protection of the privacy and integrity of the individual unless there is a specific purpose in the public interest (see art. 9.1(b) of Regulation 2018/1725) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Protection of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – commercial interests of a natural or legal person, including intellectual property; – court proceedings and legal advice – the purpose of inspections, investigations and audits • Protection of a decision making process (including negotiations), in relation to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – documents drawn up by an institution for internal use or received by an institution, which relate to a matter where the decision has not been taken by the institution, if the disclosure would seriously undermine the decision-making process. – Opinions for internal use as part of deliberations and preliminary consultations within the institution, even after a decision has been taken, if the disclosure would seriously undermine the decision-making process. <p>...unless there is an overriding public interest</p>
