We are glad to inform you that you can have wide partial access to the first document, subject only to the redaction of personal data.

Complete disclosure of this document is prevented by the exception concerning the protection of privacy and the integrity of the individual outlined in Article 4(1)(b) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, because it contains the following personal data:

- the name of Commission staff members not pertaining to the senior management;
- the names and contact details of other natural persons.

The author of the second document has objected to disclosure of the parts of the document related to the e-mail exchange as well as supplementary material that it sent to the Commission and has motivated its position with stating that these parts contain personal data as well as commercially sensitive information that is proprietary and confidential and disclosing it may undermine the protection of commercial interests of the third party in question. Therefore, disclosure of these parts of the second document are prevented by the exceptions from granting access to documents provided for by Article 4(1)(b) and 4(2), first indent, of Regulation No 1049/2001.

Please note that some documents originating from third parties are disclosed to you based on Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001. However, this disclosure is without prejudice to the rules on intellectual property, which may limit your right to reproduce or exploit the released documents without the agreement of the originator, who may hold an intellectual property right on them. The European Commission does not assume any responsibility from their reuse.
