Dear Ms Gauer,

I am writing you upon advice from [REDACTED] from the Cabinet of President von der Leyen. I am the General Secretary of CEEP, **the European cross-sectoral social partner representing public services employers and providers.**

During the last Tripartite Social Summit I had the possibility to very briefly present the attached document, showcasing a very **first set of investment plans that our members all over Europe are currently submitting to their respective governments in the context of the National Recovery and Resilience Plans.**

Few of our members were consulted by their government on those plans, others not at all. Hence CEEP wants, through this mapping exercise, to be their voice and raise awareness of EU and national institutions about the great potential, especially in terms of digital and green priorities, that investment in effective SGIs projects can represent.

The work of our members in that direction continues, despite the second wave of the pandemic. They are still firmly concentrated on the long term perspective of sustainable growth and keep sharpening their proposals. As an expl, the attached document collecting the contribution to the IT NRRP by the members of UTILITALIA, will soon be replaced by a new version where a set of smaller projects, especially in the South of Italy, have been bundled in fewer, more consistent ones. This was made under the pressure of UTILITALIA, which understood that one of the criteria for projects to be accepted is their size and their economic and job creation impact.

I made this long introduction to better argument my **request for a meeting with you:** I would like to have the opportunity to feedback to you what are the obstacles currently faced by my members in contributing to shape the NRRP and at the same time understand if and how I can support the work of your Task Force by guiding my members into criteria that would contribute to populate NRPs with high quality projects, able to directly pass the EC scrutiny.

I hope you will see in this request for a meeting a mutual benefit and look forward to your response.
