Overview of two roundtable discussions to be hosted by the Equality, Inclusion and Diversity Unit on 23 and 25 March, together with a quiz

The Equality, Inclusion and Diversity Unit will hold two roundtable discussions next week: the first on 23 March, to mark the International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination, and the second on 25 March to mark World Autism Awareness Day.

Roundtable discussion on combating racism

The meeting of 23 March on 'Tackling racism in Europe: a literary approach - and action being taken by the EP' will be the first event ever organised by the European Parliament to mark the International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination - in line with the recommendation contained in the roadmap accompanying the Papadimoulis report to the Bureau on diversities other than gender. The meeting is intended to open the debate on racial discrimination in our institution and manifest our willingness to embrace the racial diversity of staff members.
