Furthermore, bioenergy with CCS (BECCS) is now a proven technology that is in the process of being scaled up, and potentially rolled out across Europe, enabling the delivery of the negative emissions and low carbon industry that will be critical to meeting EU climate targets.

We recognise that the sustainability of the biomass we produce, and use is paramount, which is why we fully support robust, binding sustainability criteria set out in the EU legislation. The recent JRC report shows there are clear pathways for the use of wood bioenergy in the EU that can mitigate climate change while maintaining or improving forest biodiversity and ecosystem health.
