On behalf of Commissioner Kadri Simson I would like to thank you for your letter of 15 March. We are pleased to learn that Fortum has set for itself ambitious climate targets and aims to be carbon neutral latest by 2050.

As you correctly noted, the European Commission is preparing a revision of climate and energy legislation which is crucial for attaining the at least 55% climate target for 2030.

In this context, relevant Directorates-General recently submitted their proposals related to Fit for 55 package to the Regulatory Scrutiny Board. The drafting of the legislative proposals will only start in the coming months.

We would be very interested to hear about Fortum's plans for transition to renewable electricity and clean gas and believe an exchange of views on Fit for 55 would be fruitful for both sides. At the moment, however, we are at too early stages of the legislative revision and would propose to come back to fixing the date for a discussion at the end of the second quarter of the year.

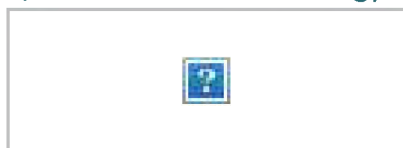
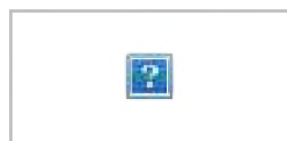

Subject: Request for a meeting with Commisisoner Kadri Simson

Dear Commissioner Simson,

I would appreciate an opportunity to meet you to explain in more detail our transition pathway, and to present our views on the role of direct and indirect electrification in decarbonization and how we can contribute to the forthcoming “Fit for 55%” legislative process. In addition, I would like to discuss with you about the role of certain technologies, especially CO2 free nuclear (including SMRs) in the EU decarbonization agenda going further.

Many of my concerns relating to the current EU agenda are connected to the draft EU Sustainable Finance taxonomy which, I believe, risks making Europe’s energy transition slower and more expensive to implement. Should you respond positively to my meeting proposal I would be pleased to elaborate on these concerns to you.
