I am contacting you on behalf of the **Nordic Coalition**, a coalition of three Nordic power companies : **Fortum**, **Statkraft** and **Vattenfall**.

Fortum, Statkraft and Vattenfall are fully committed to contributing to the European Union becoming the world's first climate-neutral continent by 2050. High 2030 and 2050 ambitions enshrined in the European Climate Law are essential to addressing climate change and to aligning the EU's joint climate policies with the Paris Agreement. The power sector can and will play a vital role towards the 2030 and 2050 climate goals, as decarbonisation through sector integration and electrification represent a historical occasion to modernise the EU's economy, revitalise its industry and ensure sustainable growth and jobs.

Following the adoption by the European Council of an ambitious EU 2030 climate target of at least -55% GHG emissions by 2030 and in parallel to the inter-institutional negotiations on the European Climate Law, **we support a swift adjustment of the EU 2030 climate and energy policy framework**. In light of the upcoming "Fit for 55%" package, we call for strengthening and enlarging the EU ETS as a key driver for decarbonization while enhancing electrification across the various sectors of the economy.

In your capacity as Member of Cabinet of Commissioner Kadri Simson, in charge of climate policies such as EU ETS, [REDACTED] Fortum, [REDACTED] Statkraft and [REDACTED] Public & Regulatory Affairs EU would be delighted to virtually meet and exchange views with you on the upcoming initiatives under the Fit for 55 package in the upcoming weeks. We could propose April 26th (11.00), April 28th (16.00), May 3rd (11.00), May 5th (afternoon) or May 6th (13.00, 14.00 or 16.00) but are also open to suggestion from your side.
