DOCUMENT PARTIALLY ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC (30.06.2021)

1. On 12 April 2011, the Council adopted Decision 2011/235/CFSP concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities in view of the situation in Iran and Regulation (EU) No 359/2011 concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies in view of the situation in Iran.
2. On 22 April 2021, the Middle East/Gulf Working Party (MOG) considered a delisting request from the Cyber Police of the Islamic Republic of Iran and agreed to maintain the listing.
3. On 28 April 2021, the Foreign Relations Counsellors Working Party agreed on the draft reply letter to this delisting request as set out in Annex to this note.
