I refer to your e-mail of 18 November 2021, registered on 19 November 2021, in which you submit a confirmatory application in accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents<sup>1</sup> (hereafter 'Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001').

Your confirmatory application was submitted in relation to your initial application of 31 August 2021, in which you requested access to the following documents:

- '- Internal documents discussing a possible 'right to repair' of electronic devices dating from since January 1st, 2021
- Documents from stakeholders concerning a possible "right to repair" since the beginning of 2021, including minutes of meetings, e-mails and other documents[...].'

A holding reply was sent to you, dated 22 September 2021, our reference Ares(2021)5785849, whereby we informed you that the time limit for handling your application was extended by 15 working days pursuant to Article 7(3), and given the
