YOUR INITIAL APPLICATION 2014-01 UNDER REGULATION (EC) 1049/2001

Dear Mr Lindenberg,

On 10 February 2014, you lodged an application under Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents¹ (hereinafter “the Regulation”), in order to obtain access to “documents relating to the contract award 2014/S 016-023613 (TED)”, which pertains to the following procurement procedure: 13.CAP.OP.622 “Non-Lethal Micro-Wave State-of-the-Art Study”.

All documents related to the open tender procedure in question were published on the European Defence Agency’s Procurement webpage and remain freely available at the following URL:
