[REDACTED], on 21 October 2021 sometime between 11h30 and 14h30, to discuss the implementation of the EU offshore energy strategy and reform of the renewables energy directive, Equinor's contribution to a sustainable blue economy as well as hybrid offshore wind opportunities in Europe.
