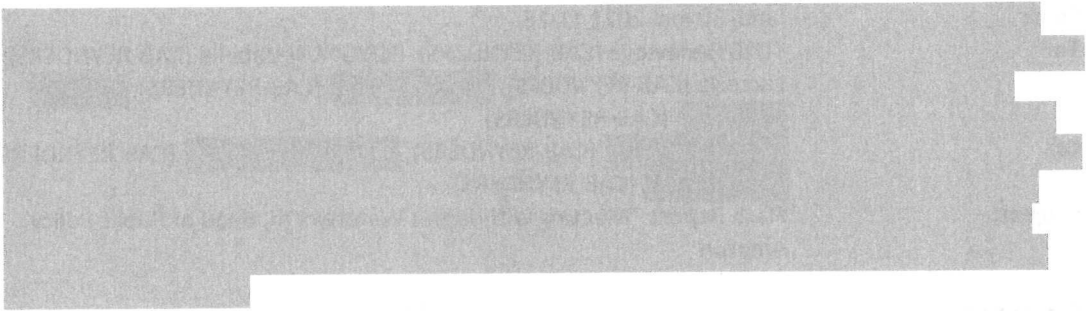
Flash Report – Meeting with Amazon – consumer policy & product safety

- **General Product Safety Regulation:** we touched upon the GPSR proposal. Amazon is supportive of the review but not of the current configuration of the requirements concerning Responsible person for products placed on the Union market as they consider this as a “letter box” concept. Would support a more substantial concept of meaningful responsible person (e.g. professional entity) with an accreditation system which to interact with safety authorities and customs (and stakeholders). Amazon also noted the importance of having sufficient time to implement the GSPR as of its adoption. They underlined that the deadline decided in the trilogues for the DSA was too short (7 months) and insisted they need more than 6 months for the implementation of the GPSR.
