I really would value the opportunity to underline for you that fertilizers in themselves are nutrients that plants and we as humans need to take up in our bodies to lead healthy lives. Fertilizers are not a problem. It is the losses from excess use, in practise often manure, that are a problem because such losses give rise to environmental problems. It was a disappointment for me that the first drafts of the Farm to Fork Strategy talked about limiting fertilizer use. I feel that is a populist and un-scientific approach not focusing on the real problem. We have proposed to build a policy around increases in nutrient use efficiency, which will reduce losses and which is an approach backed by scientist.
Given that the covid-19 situation has shown that science and food security do matter, I was hoping that would also be reflected in the upcoming strategy.
