Dear Mr Keus,

Thank you for your request for access to documents of the Council of the European Union.<sup>1</sup>

You have requested access to documents containing “*a detailed account of the expenses (invoices, receipts, contracts) so that it becomes clear which companies benefit from the EU fund for Ukraine. This should include both the existing funding as well as the additional funding in the MFF (MultiAnnual Financial Framework) 2021-2027.*”

We have not identified any document in the Council’s possession that would fall within the scope of your access request.

Please note that :

- a) there is currently no mention of any “EU fund for Ukraine” on the EU budget;
- b) the adoption of the proposed Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on establishing the Ukraine Facility is still pending.
