Dear Mr [REDACTED]

IOGP welcomes the Paris Agreement. Yet we are worried about potential ETS developments for Gas Extraction due to poor Eurostat data.

Actually DG Clima is presently assessing whether Gas Extraction meets the requirements set by the new ETS Directive for Carbon Leakage protection, based on Eurostat data. Previous DG Clima assessment led to an exclusion of this protection for Gas Extraction and we are much worried as Eurostat data showed up significant inconsistencies.

A recent NERA study mandated by the industry actually revealed a Carbon Leakage indicator of 0.21, which is above the 0.20 thresholds giving direct access to CL protection.

The situation is all the more worried that without this protection, earlier cessation of gas extraction activities is expected, meaning that more gas will be imported from outside Europe, while Europe gas production is good for 30% less CO2 emissions than the world average...

We would most welcome the opportunity to meet you and/or your colleagues in charge, as soon as possible, to explain in more details the situation.

We can suggest the following dates and hope that one of them will be convenient:
