Nice seeing you yesterday and thanks again for joining our methane emissions conference.

I'm reaching out to see whether you'd be open to a brief informal exchange in the coming days. We are working on an informal coalition of European and international industry associations across the gas (+now also oil) value chain - we already have a good buy in and growing. We want to develop a joint action plan - commitments, not just requests. Ideally, we'd like to do this in collaboration with EC and MS. Objective is to support the implementation of the Methane Emissions Regulation.

We're currently exploring possible approaches around certification and traceability requirements under the regulation. We've already had a first more technical exchange with [REDACTED] and C2 colleagues some time ago - then still only as Eurogas.

Before we take this further in the hierarchy, I'd really value your initial thoughts on the direction we're taking. Would you be available for a short call or coffee?
