<b>Subject matter:</b>	<i>Compliance with the import requirements of the EU Methane Regulation</i>
<b>Main points raised and positions expressed:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Eurogas presented the approach to compliance they are developing. They emphasised that it is urgent to find solutions.</i></li><li>• <i>Commission encouraged Eurogas to pursue work on this topic while exploring also how the system could incentivise good behaviour.</i></li><li>• <i>Commission emphasised that the ultimate responsibility to decide whether a system is compliant lies with Member States competent authorities. The Commission is aware of a number of solutions under development, some of which look very promising in terms of robustness and incentivising methane emissions abatement which is the ultimate aim of the regulation.</i></li></ul>
