Subject: Your application for access to documents (Case 2024/1558)

Dear Sir, / Dear Madam,

We refer to your request for access to European Commission documents registered under the above-mentioned reference number.

You request access to all documentation, including but not limited to attendance lists, agendas, background papers, minutes/notes and email correspondence from, about or summarising, the following meeting: **meeting of Director General Ditte Juul Jorgenson and Chamber of Commerce of the United States of America regarding energy security on 30/10/2023.**

The following documents fall within the scope of your application:

- Briefing Meeting DJJ – US EU Chamber of Commerce (hereafter “document 1”)
- Correspondence ahead of the meeting (hereafter “document 2”)

Having examined the documents requested under the provisions of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to documents, I have come to the conclusion that documents 1 and 2 may be partially disclosed. Some parts of the documents have been blanked out as their disclosure is prevented by exceptions to the right of access laid down in Article 4(1)(a) and Article 4(1)(b) of this Regulation. Disclosure of these parts would undermine the protection of international relations and the private and integrity of individuals, in accordance with EU legislation regarding the protection of personal data.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position. Such a confirmatory application should be addressed to the Secretariat-General of the Commission within 15 working days upon receipt of this letter. You can submit it in one of the following ways:
