Dear Vice-President Dombrovskis,

[REDACTED] of thyssenkrupp Steel AG, will be in Brussels on Tuesday 28th of February and would very much welcome the opportunity to meet and discuss the key aspects of the Commission Green Deal Industrial Plan critical for the decarbonization of the steel industry.

The landmark agreement on the reform of the EU ETS and the introduction of a CBAM sets incentives for scaling climate-friendly technologies - such as H₂-based direct reduction in the steel sector. At the same time the scope for investment is maintained despite rising CO₂ costs for existing plants until 2030. With the investment in our first Direct Reduction plant announced last September, we are embarking on the transition of Europe's largest steel plant towards climate neutrality and making an important contribution to achieving European climate targets. Availability of competitively priced low-carbon electricity and hydrogen are one of the key success factors for European industry to lead this transition and secure basic materials such as steel for a competitive and resilient European Economy. Therefore, the Green Deal Industrial Plan is a much needed industrial policy initiative.

We very much look forward to a constructive dialogue with you and the European Commission and would appreciate the opportunity to meet and discuss in more detail how thyssenkrupp Steel can help on meeting the EU's climate ambitions while keeping European steel industry competitive.

We will be contacting your office to seek a mutually agreeable time for a meeting.
