Dear Mr Nelson,

We refer to your request for access to European Commission documents registered on 8 August 2024.

You request access to “*All documentation, including, but not limited to, attendance lists, agendas, background papers, minutes/notes and email correspondence about or summarising the following meetings between:*

1) Meetings between Roxana Lesovici, Cabinet member of Adina Vălean and Royal Caribbean Group on "Maritime" or "Martime" on 14/02/2023”.

We regret to inform you that the Directorate-General for Mobility and Transport does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application.

Indeed, after carrying out the relevant searches in the Commission’s corporate document management system, we were not able to retrieve any documents relating to the meeting in question, which was a short bilateral meeting.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to documents¹, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Given that no such documents, corresponding to the description given in your application, are held by the Commission, the Commission is not in a position to fulfil your request.
