Subject: Your application for access to documents – Ref No 2024/2453

We refer to your e-mail of 13 May 2024 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 14 May 2024 under the above-mentioned reference number.

With regard to the scope of your request, namely:

- evidence of all correspondence (including phone calls, conference calls, video conferences, minutes of meetings, etc.) held between the DG and representatives of the Azerbaijan government regarding COP29 since 1 January 2023;
- evidence of all correspondence (including phone calls, conference calls, video conferences, minutes of meetings, etc.) held between the DG and representatives of SOCAR regarding COP29 since 1 January 2023

We regret to inform you that the Commission does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application.
