Consultation of Member States : In which language? To which address?

The consultations of Member states must:

- be written **in the language of the EM**;

If you encounter difficulties in obtaining a timely translation of the consultation in the language of the Member State, it is always possible to send the consultation in English, **except for**:

- Spanish, French and Italian Authorities that have explicitly asked to be consulted in their national language;
- any other national Authority which would require to be consulted in its national language.
- be **sent to the Permanent Representation' contact point address** indicated in the list updated by our colleagues at Council. Please consult the list available on our website: https://myintracomm.ec.europa.eu/sg/docinter/Documents/gi_conseil.pdf;
- clearly **mention the GESTDEM reference** of the request in the subject;
- (if sent by email) not include heavy attachments (max 3MB).

Furthermore, we draw your attention to the fact that it has been agreed with the **Permanent Representation of Spain** that the consultations will be addressed to [REDACTED], with copy to the functional mailbox Acceso.Documentos@reper.maec.es.
