Request for information

By e-mail of September 9th 2024, you requested information from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark as follows:

"In my original message, I requested the access to documents (under Denmark's Public Administration Act, Lov om offentlighed i forvaltningen nr 606 af 12/06/2013), which contain the following information:

-How many meetings have employees of the Permanent Representation of Denmark to the EU had in the context of or relating to the topic of New Genomic Techniques (NGTs) with representatives of companies, lobby or advocacy groups, academic, research, and scientific institutes, consultancies, and any other kind of organisations and stakeholders, from January 2022 until today?

I would like to request a list of these meetings: who was present at the meeting, including the names of organisations/lobbyists present, as well as the date of the meeting, the subject matter discussed, and the minutes of the meetings."

Your request is being processed under the rules of the 2013 Danish Freedom of Information Act (Offentlighedsloven).

It is not possible for the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs to answer your request within seven working days from the receipt, cf. article 36, section 2, 2nd line.

This is due to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs being in the process of answering other requests for information, which were received prior to your own request of September 9th 2024.

The Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs expects to be able to answer your request for information within 2 weeks.
